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## Guidelines for Evaluation of Final year B.E., M.Tech. & MCA students

In view of the unprecedented situation resulted due to COVID-19, examinations of final year UG & PG students were not conducted as per the declared schedule in the academic calendar. As per the guidelines issued by the various authorities from time to time and the recommendations of the committee appointed for this purpose, the online examination will be conducted.

1. End Semester Examinations (ESE) for the even term of Academic Year 2019-20 for **Final year students** of B.E., M. Tech. & MCA (CBCS / Non CBCS) and students of all classes with **backlog** of lower classes shall be conducted in the form of an **Online** test of **Multiple Choice Questions** (MCQ) type. wherever MCQ is not possible due to the nature of the course, examination shall be assignment based. The examination shall be conducted online.

2. <u>For Final Year</u>: The ESE Question paper shall be based on **three unit's syllabus**. Question paper set shall have **30/60 multiple choice questions** for a maximum of **60 marks** with examination duration of **90 minutes**.

3.<u>For Final Year:</u> Class test I was already conducted for regular students. However, Class test I will be conducted only for the students who were unable to give Class test I due to valid reasons

4. <u>For Final Year:</u> Class test II was not conducted, In lieu of Class Test II, teacher may use any approach or tool for evaluation of Class Test II (like Assignments/ Presentations / Open Book Test / Quiz / MCQ / Case Study / Oral *etc.*).

5. **Backlog courses of all students:** The ESE question paper shall be based on

complete syllabus. Question paper set shall have 30/60 multiple choice questions for a maximum of 60 marks with examination duration of 90 minutes

6. Students who have <u>applied for improvement</u> shall appear for the ESE only. The class test II will not be conducted for these students. The final performance shall be the performance of Class test I, performance in ESE and earlier performance of Class test II.

7. <u>For Final Year</u>: The term work of Laboratory courses / mini projects / projects completed till 14<sup>th</sup> March 2020 shall be evaluated based on quality of submission / assignment / oral or any other appropriate online tool as decided and declared by the course teacher.

8. **For Final Year:** Practical / Oral / Project examination shall be conducted online on WebEx platform.

9. **For Part Time Courses**: All the above guidelines are also applicable for part time courses with appropriate changes.
