**Circular and Guidelines for Evaluation of First year B.Tech., M.Tech. & MCA students**

In view of the unprecedented situation resulted due to COVID-19, online examinations of first year UG & PG students will be conducted as per the following guidelines:

1] End Semester Examinations (ESE) for the odd semester of Academic Year 2020-21 for **First year students** of B.Tech, M.Tech. & MCA and those students who's First Year Backlog Subject shall be conducted in the form of an **Online test of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)** type. The examination shall be conducted online through Institute MIS platform.

2] For Non CBCS/ Part-time students not registered in institute MIS, respective faculty shall conduct the online **Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)** type examinations using any online appropriate tools as per exam schedule. Details of such student shall be sent by CoE to faculty and HoD

3] The ESE Question paper shall be based on **complete syllabus**. Question paper set shall have **multiple choice questions** for a maximum of **60 marks** with examination duration of **90 minutes** except for **Mathematics** course it will be **120 minutes**.

4] The **ESE** will be conducted from **24/05/2021**, Detail time table will be declared by the Controller of Examination shortly..

## Guidelines to Online Examination for Students

### Important Instructions

- Arrange for stable Internet connectivity.
- Giving examination on Laptop or Desktop is highly recommended.
- Make sure mobile/laptop is fully charged. Power bank for mobile or UPS/Inverter for laptop/desktop should be arranged for uninterrupted power supply.
- Students should have sufficient data in Fair Usage Policy (FUP) / Internet plan with sufficient data pack of internet service provider.
- Login to the portal 10 min before the online examination start time.
- Close all browsers/tabs before starting the online examination.
- Once the exam starts, do not switch to any other window/tab. On doing so, your attempt may be considered as malpractice and your exam may get terminated.
- Do Not Pickup/Receive the Call during the exam if you are giving the exam on mobile. This also will be treated as changing the window.
- To avoid unwanted pop-ups, use of Ad Blocker is recommended.
- Clear browser cache memory on mobile and laptops. Clear browsing history and also delete temp files.

### Notes:

- It is recommended to use web browser such as Mozilla and Chrome browsers etc. on a desktop/laptop/tab/smart phone.
- Do not use the back button of keyboard or close button/icon to go back to previous page or to close the screen.
- **Student will not allow to login after 30 min from the start of examination.**
