Provisional Guidelines for Evaluation of FY, SY, TY of B.Tech., FY of M.Tech. & FY, SY of MCA students

The unprecedented situation resulted due to COVID-19 forced some changes in the Academic systems and Calendar for the students of current Academic Year 2019-20. After studying the directives from UGC & State Government, discussion with student representatives, Faculty members and Academic Council Members, following guidelines are formulated by the committee.

- End Semester Examinations for the even term of Academic Year 2019-20 shall not be conducted for FY, SY, and TY of B.Tech., FY of M.Tech. & FY, SY of MCA students.
- 2. The scheme of "Carry forward" will be allowed for the current academic year (2019-20) and every student registered during academic year (2019-20) shall be permitted for admission to next year irrespective of his/her backlog. However, such students shall pass the examination for the course (s) in which he/ she has failed/ remained absent, as and when the examination(s) of such courses will be held.
- 3. Grades in the courses of current semester will be decided based on the performance of student in the internal assessment during current semester and performance of the immediate past semester. The weightage for different components of evaluation to be used in deciding grade in a course/s (including re-registered courses) is given in the following table:

- 4. Class test I was already conducted. However, Class test I will be conducted for the students who were unable to give Class test I due to valid reasons.
- 5. For Teachers Assessment in lieu of Class Test II & internal assessment, teacher may use any approach or tool (like Assignments/ Presentations/Open Book Test/ Quiz/ MCQ /Case Study/ Oral *etc.*).
- 6. For Class Test & internal assessment of M. Tech., MCA & Non CBCS students, guidelines provided in point no. 5 shall be followed.
- 7. Faculty shall provide enough learning material to the students.
- 8. For Laboratory course/ mini projects/ project, the students are to be given exposure to laboratory assignments / practical assignments through virtual laboratories, digital recourses available or relevant information on laboratory experiments in lieu of non conduct of laboratory experiments/exercises by the course teacher.

- 9. Term work assessment of Laboratory course/ mini projects/ projects covered till 14th March may be based on submission/ assignment/oral or any appropriate feasible online tool.
- 10. The hardware project may be modified to include modelling/ simulation/ analysis using secondary data, software application or any relevant theoretical study.
- 11. If the student wishes to improve the grades, he/she may appear in exams for such subjects during next semester. Performance in this examination will override the earlier performance.
- 12. Result of RE-ESE has been declared. In case if the students are not satisfied with the evaluation, he/she may apply for re-evaluation by sending email to coeoffice@geca.ac.in within two weeks mentioning the enrolment no., class & course details. Answer sheets of only those students will be re-evaluated as & when college is resumed. The students will have to pay fees of Rs.400/ per course. The result of such students will be declared as per re-evaluation.
- 13. Above guidelines shall be applicable to part time students also.
- 14. The guidelines for the evaluation of final year students shall be declared in due course of time.
